1/ How to Register for CAG Summer Camps 2024 Using the Amilia SmartRec System

- 1. Visit https://www.amilia.com/store/en/CAG_OldOttawaEast/shop/programs
- 2. Click on the Summer Camps 2024 Button.
- 3. Click on the Toggle to Open the Week of Camp you are interested in.
- 4. Click the Green **Session** button to begin the registration of the camp you would like to register for.
- 5. A pop-up window will appear to Log In, Create an Account, or Reset Your Password.
- 6. If you have an Amilia SmartRec account, please sign in. If you haven't created an Amilia SmartRec account before, you will be asked to create an **ADULT** account (email and password). Please do not create another **ADULT** account. If you have forgotten your password, please follow the reset your password procedure by clicking on the link at the bottom of that window.
- 7. After you have signed into or created your **ADULT** account in Amilia SmartRec, select the participant (your child) from the list of children in your account or click on ADD ANOTHER PERSON at the bottom of the list to add your child if this is the first activity they are registering for.
- 8. The Amilia SmartRec system will send you a VERIFICATION EMAIL. Please respond to this email right away to verify your account.
- 9. You can now return to ADD other weeks of camp by selecting the **Continue Shopping** button at the bottom of this window.
- 10. When you have finished selecting all the camps you would like to register for select the CHECKOUT button on the bottom right of this window and then proceed to completing the registration and payment for your purchases.
- 11. Please only add children that are in your family or that you have guardianship of. Children can not be registered to multiple families in the system.

CAG Summer Camps 2024 Overview

CAG's Summer Camps 2024 provides 10 weeks of summer camp fun for children ages 4 to 14, right here in Old Ottawa East at the Brantwood Park Fieldhouse (CAMP Brantwood), and Old Town Hall (CAMP Old Town Hall).

CAMP BRANTWOOD 2024

Registration for CAMP BRANTWOOD camps is divided into 3 groups, by age:

- 1. Speckled Frogs Ages 4-6 (8 spots*)
- 2. Dragonflies Ages 7-9 (8 spots*)
- 3. Blue Jays Ages 10-12 (8 spots*)

*CAG reserves the right to adjust the number of spots available for each camp by age to meet the demand.

Each day the Speckled Frogs, Dragonflies, and Blue Jays will have separate, age-appropriate, activities that will be sure to keep them engaged and active. We also have some all-group activities and field trips that will bring the children all together.

CAMP OLD TOWN HALL 2024

The activities for each **Camp Old Town Hall** camp will be geared to the wide variety of experience and skills of the participants to keep campers engaged and active. Each week of camp will have all-group activities and will include outdoor activities and games.

CAG will contact registrants to discuss the level of experience that each participant has for the camps **Be In the Band – Music Camp** and **This Camp Bytes - Coding Camp** after registration to understand the level of experience of each camper.

WEEKLY CAMP ACTIVITIES

Each week of camp will be filled with fun activities including crafts, hands-on experiments, gardening and nature activities, bicycle trips to parks (Bike Camps) or landmarks in Ottawa, canoe paddling (Canoe Camps), field sports and games, forest and river shore adventures, off-site field trips, musical activities, daily swimming and pool fun in our awesome Brantwood Park outdoor pool, and so much more.

BEFORE and AFTER Camp Care

CAG will **NOT** be providing **BEFORE** care for CAMP BRANTWOOD or CAMP OLD TOWN HALL 2024 camps.

AFTER Camp Care will be provided for each week of camp at **CAMP BRANTWOOD only**.

Campers from CAMP OLD TOWN HALL that register for AFTER Camp Care will head to CAMP BRANTWOOD at 3:00 pm each day (except for Thursday Aug 1, 2024, for the Be In the Band Campperformance day at Old Town Hall!)

AFTER Camp Care will be available from 3:00 pm to 5:15 pm daily. Please register in advance!

AFTER Camp Care activities will include free play time, crafts, swimming, and games.

Parents/Caregivers are welcome to pickup their children anytime between 3:15 pm – 5:15 pm from the AFTER Camp care program at CAMP BRANTWOOD.

AFTER Camp Care: 3:00 – 5:15 pm - \$60.00/week (\$48/week for Week 2 and Week 7)

WAITLISTS

CAG Summer Camps are very popular, and registration will fill up fast. If you are interested in a camp, but it is currently full, please add your child to the **WAITLIST(s)** for each individual camp week using the waitlist tool in Amilia SmartRec. Open spots will be automatically offered to you from the Waitlist in order of when your waitlist application is received. *You will have 24 hours to register your child from the time the WAITLIST offer email is received.*

PRO TIP: Please add the email <u>notifications@amilia.com</u> to your Safe Sender List to ensure you receive these messages.

Please note: CAG will not be keeping a manual waitlist for any camps this year, you must use the Amilia SmartRec system to use the waitlist system.

CAG Summer Camps 2024 Refund Policy:

- Cancellation **30 days or more before** the Camp **start date**: Full refund minus a \$25 admin fee.
- Cancellation within 2 weeks (14 days) before Camp start date: 50% of the camp fee will be refunded.
- Cancellation within 1 week (7 days) before Camp start date: No refund will be provided.
- Cancellations for a camp due to medical reasons will be accepted with a medical note from a medical doctor.

PLEASE HELP US HELP YOU: CAG works very hard to provide engaging, affordable, and accessible summer camps for the community. To help us in this effort, please cancel any camp as soon as you have made other arrangements so that **we can quickly offer that space to another child**. This also helps CAG manage our costs.

FINANCIAL ASSITANCE

CAG supports access to its programming by offering registration fee assistance to families and individuals who are eligible. The purpose of the fee assistance policy is to reduce financial barriers to participation in programming offered by CAG and is designed to ensure that any resident of Old Ottawa East has access to programming, regardless of his or her ability to pay.

Each household is eligible for annual maximum fee assistance of up to \$150.00.

Animal Planet – Nature Camp

Calling all animal lovers! Join us as we explore animals from around the world and learn *fun facts about some of nature's most amazing creatures and where they live.* The week is packed with activities, games, and wild excitement for your camper to let loose and enjoy themselves.

Week 2 – Jul 2 - 5, 2024 (4 days) Location: Brantwood Park Fieldhouse (39 Onslow Crescent, K1S 1G3) Cost: \$215.00



Canoe Camp (7 to 12 yrs. olds)

"Canoe believe this view? Oar am I just seeing things?", Someone's Dad

Come explore the amazing Rideau River and join in on fun water-based adventures this Summer. Canoers will improve their paddling and water safety skills and enjoy a variety of exciting water-based fun. When campers are not on the Rideau River, they will have time to play a bunch of awesome landbased games and activities. During canoe camp weeks, campers will be in the canoes each day.

Prerequisites for Canoe Camps (all weeks):

- No paddling experience is required to participate in the CAG Canoe Camps
- All paddlers registered for Canoe Camps must be able to successfully pass a Swim Test that will be conducted in early June 2024. Three (3) dates will be provided.
- Campers must successfully complete the following swim test in its entirety, without any stops, in sequence, with or without a personal flotation device (P.F.D.)
 - 1. Rolling entry (backwards or forward) into deep water at 2.75m (9') minimum depth
 - 2. Tread water for 1 minute
 - 3. Swim 50m (164') continuously any stroke

Please note: This swim test criteria are provided by OPHEA - Ontario Physical Activity Safety Standards. More information on these standards can be found <u>here</u>.



Some Experience* Campers (6 campers+) will build on what campers know playing guitar/bass/drums/keyboard/vocals/other?? to come together (he he!) with their bandmates to ROCK IT for the *Thursday performance for their families*. CAG will have rented instruments and campers will let us know what they play, (or want to play) when you register!

* **Some Experience** is a budding musician that can move between 3-4 chords easily, on their instrument of choice (guitar/bass/keyboard/other?)
